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AGREED FINAL JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court, and after being advised that the parties agree to the entry of this Judgment, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. Plaintiff, Louis DeSimone, P.O. Box 220498, Hollywood, Florida 33022, shall recover from Baptist Health Medical Group, Inc., 6855 Red Road, Suite 600, Coral Gables, Florida 33143, the principal amount of \$1,001.00 plus interest at a rate pursuant to section 55.03, Florida Statutes, for which let execution issue.

2. Plaintiff is also entitled to recover attorneys' fees and costs pursuant to section 559.77(2), legal assistants' fees pursuant to section 57.104, and may be entitled to fees and costs pursuant to section 57.115. The Court reserves jurisdiction to determine the amount and render judgment.

3. Plaintiff is excused from filing a post judgment motion under Rule 7.175. If the parties cannot settle within a reasonable time, either party can schedule a hearing to determine the amount of Plaintiff's fees and costs.

4. Plaintiff is not liable to Defendant for the alleged debt stated in the Complaint.

5. Should any marks pertaining to the alleged debt stated in the Complaint appear on Plaintiff's credit report with TransUnion, Equifax, and/or Experian, upon request from Plaintiff, Defendant shall confirm with such credit reporting agency that the alleged debt is not owed by Plaintiff.

6. It is further ordered and adjudged that the Defendant shall complete Florida Small Claims Rules Form 7.343 (Fact Information Sheet) and return it to the Plaintiff's attorney, or to the Plaintiff if the Plaintiff is not represented by an attorney, within 45 days from the date of this Judgment, unless the Judgment is satisfied or a motion for new trial or notice of appeal is filed. **The Defendant should NOT file the completed form 7.343 with the Court.**

7. Jurisdiction of this case is retained to enter further orders that are proper to compel the Defendant to complete form 7.343 and return it to the Plaintiff's attorney, or the Plaintiff if the plaintiff is not represented by an attorney.
